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

Lordship/Hearing the Voice of God

Definition of Freedom

- Freedom is not defined by what is absent, rather freedom is defined by Who is present.
- Freedom is not the absence of something, but the presence of Someone.

Definition

Lordship: Supreme power or rule.

KEY CONCEPTS

When we listen to the voice of the Lord:

- We prove that He is Lord of our lives.
- We want to follow Him in every area of our lives and nothing is off limits to Him.
- We give Him complete permission to do or say anything over our lives.

Four reasons to why we may struggle with Lordship:

- We have not surrendered completely to Him or placed Him as first priority in our lives.
- Lack of understanding.
- Rebellion
- Fear or lack of trust.

KEY SCRIPTURES

Matthew 19:16-22 (NKJV) - Now behold, one came and said to Him, "Good[a] Teacher, what good thing shall I do that I may have eternal life?" So He said to him, [b]"Why do you call Me good? [c]No one is good but One, that is, God. But if you want to enter into life, keep the commandments." He said to Him, "Which ones?" Jesus said, "'You shall not murder,' You shall not commit adultery,' You shall not steal,' You shall not bear false witness,' 19 'Honor your father and your mother,' and, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' "The young man said to Him, "All these things I have kept [d]from my youth. What do I still lack?" Jesus said to him, "If you want to be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me." But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions.

Lordship/Hearing the Voice of God

Matthew 14:24-29 (NKJV) But the boat was now [a]in the middle of the sea, tossed by the waves, for the wind was contrary. Now in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went to them, walking on the sea. 26 And when the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, "It is a ghost!" And they cried out for fear. But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, [b]"Be of good cheer! [c]It is I; do not be afraid." And Peter answered Him and said, "Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water." So He said, "Come." And when Peter had come down out of the boat, he walked on the water to go to Jesus.

Genesis 3:1-7 (NKJV) - Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?" And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden; 3 but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die.' "Then the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die. 5 For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was [a]pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate. Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves [b]coverings.

Ephesians 4:7 (NKJV) - But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift.

Genesis 16:2-4 (NKJV) - So Sarai said to Abram, "See now, the Lord has restrained me from bearing children. Please, go in to my maid; perhaps I shall [a]obtain children by her." And Abram heeded the voice of Sarai. Then Sarai, Abram's wife, took Hagar her maid, the Egyptian, and gave her to her husband Abram to be his wife, after Abram had dwelt ten years in the land of Canaan. So he went in to Hagar, and she conceived. And when she saw that she had conceived, her mistress became despised in her eyes.

MINISTRY TIME

Ask: Lord, what lie have I believed about You, others or myself?

As the Holy Spirit reveals to you the lie; **Agree** with Him. (Yes, you are right, I have believed this as a lie.) **Repent**. (Lord, I'm sorry for believing this lie.) **Renounce**. (Lord, I renounce this lie and its influences over my life in Jesus' name.)

Ask: Lord, what is Your truth?



Ask: Lord, what is Your truth?

As the Holy Spirit reveals to you the truth; **Agree** with Him. (Yes, you are right. This is Your truth.) **Receive** (Receive what He tells you as truth.) **Believe** (Begin believing what He says about His truth, rather than believing the lie.)

Prayer: Lord, please forgive me for believing (the lie) about myself. I break my agreement with this lie. Lord, I ask You to cleanse and renew my mind with Your truth. Help me hear who You say I am. I will no longer accept this lie. The power of this lie is broken now, in the name of Jesus. AMEN!


KEY SCRIPTURES

I AM REDEEMED BY A LOVING GOD

KEY SCRIPTURES

John 4:3-26 ESV – "...he (Jesus) left Judea and departed again for Galilee. And he had to pass through Samaria. So he came to a town of Samaria called Sychar, near the field that Jacob had given to his son Joseph. Jacob's well was there; so Jesus, wearied as he was from his journey, was sitting beside the well. It was about the sixth hour, A woman from Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her, 'Give me a drink.' (For his disciples had gone away into the city to buy food.) The Samaritan woman said to him, 'How is it that you, a Jew, ask for a drink from me, a woman of Samaria?' (For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.) Jesus answered her, 'If you knew the gift of God, and who it is that is saying to you, "Give me a drink," you would have asked him, and he would have given you living water.' The woman said to him, 'Sir, you have nothing to draw water with, and the well is deep. Where do you get that living water? Are you greater than our father Jacob? He gave us the well and drank from it himself, as did his sons and his livestock.' Jesus said to her, 'Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.' The woman said to him, 'Sir, give me this water, so that I will not be thirsty or have to come here to draw water.' Jesus said to her, 'Go, call your husband, and come here.' The woman answered him, 'I have no husband.' Jesus said to her, 'You are right in saying, "I have no husband"; for you have had five husbands, and the one you now have is not your husband. What you have said is true.' The woman said to him, 'Sir, I perceive that you are a prophet. Our fathers worshiped on this mountain, but you say that in Jerusalem is the place where people ought to worship.' Jesus said to her, 'Woman, believe me, the hour is coming when neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem will you worship the Father. You worship what you do not know; we worship what we know, for salvation is from the Jews. But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him. God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.' The woman said to him, 'I know that Messiah is coming (he who is called Christ). When he comes, he will tell us all things.' Jesus said to her, 'I who speak to you am he.'"

2 Corinthians 7:2 NKJV – "Open your hearts to us. We have wronged no one, we have corrupted no one, we have cheated no one."

Psalm 103:12 NKJV – "As far as the east is from the west, So far has He removed our transgressions from us."

I AM REDEEMED BY A LOVING GOD

APPLICATION

Bring the real truth to the surface; the process of healing and being set free could begin in his life. Until we bring what happened in darkness to the light, we can never be truly set free. What do I need forgiveness from? We need forgiveness from the sins, which we have committed against God, others and ourselves. Forgiveness allows us to disconnect from ourselves and to connect into God as our Source.

Forgiveness is surrendering to Jesus our right to hold a judgment against someone and letting God be judge and jury. It does not in any way, justify sin or remove accountability.

Forgiveness Does Not Mean

- We somehow try to forget what has happened- forgiveness does not erase the past, what happened to you, happened.
- Wrong is minimized or that the person is declared not guilty- through forgiveness, we are handing over the case to a higher court, who will then decide what happens to you.
- We deny our anger or pain- if we have been hurt greatly, there is an emotion attached to it and you're not a robot. It's okay to express how you feel.
- We avoid confrontation- doesn't mean we become a doormat and allow that person to come fully back into our life.
- Others are then obligated and indebted to us, therefore, owing us somethingforgiveness has no strings attached to it; God forgives us freely.
- We don't have to trust the person who has hurt us, again- forgiveness and trust are not the same thing. If someone has wronged us, it doesn't mean that he/she is allowed fully back into our life.

Forgiveness Does Mean

- Forgiving from the heart.
- Bringing the balance to zero; they owe you nothing.
- Giving to God "our right of revenge."

How do you Release God?

- You need to be honest and tell God your complaint.
- Make a list of what you are truthfully thankful for.
- Fight self-pity and entitlement.
- Choose to believe that God is just and He has a purpose for what is going on in this moment.

MINISTRY TIME

Ask: Lord, would you reveal any unforgiveness in my heart? If He says, "yes," ask Him the names of anyone, who you have not forgiven?

Ask: Lord, do I need to forgive myself? If the Lord said, "yes" to you, then you now have an opportunity to choose to forgive yourself. Remember, forgiveness is a choice.

Ask: Lord, do I need to forgive someone else? If the Lord has said, "yes," then you now have an opportunity to choose to forgive others. Remember, forgiveness is a choice.

I AM REDEEMED BY A LOVING GOD

Ask: Lord, do I need to release You from an area in my life, that I am holding against You? If the Lord has said, "yes," then you now have an opportunity to choose to release Him. Remember, releasing is a choice.

Ask: Lord, what was the event that caused me to become hurt?

Ask: Lord, when this event happened in my life, would You bring the emotions I felt to the surface?

I AM REDEEMED BY A LOVING GOD

Prayer: We choose to forgive ourselves: Thank You, Father, for forgiving me. I now choose to forgive myself for the things I know You have already forgiven me for. I specifically forgive myself for (name the personal offenses and emotions). Please take these emotions from me and place them on the cross. I open my heart to receive what You want to give me, in exchange for the hurt. Thank You for healing the effects of these sins in my soul. In Jesus' name, AMEN!

Prayer: We choose to forgive others: Dear Lord, I choose to forgive (name of person) for (name their offense). Father, when they did these things, I felt (describe the effects of the sins). Please take these emotions from me and place them on the cross. I open my heart to receive what You want to give me, in exchange for the hurt. Thank You for healing the effects of these sins in my soul. In Jesus' name, AMEN!

Prayer: Let us choose to forgive God for something in our life, when we have wrongly blamed Him: Dear God, I confess that there have been times when I have blamed you; Lord, for things that are not Your responsibility (be specific). I recognize this to be sin and I ask You to forgive me. I know that You hate what Satan has done in my life. Thank You for loving me and promising to set me free. AMEN!

Closing Prayer: You are my Source and my life. I ask You to speak Your word of truth, in place of every lie that distorts my way of seeing others and receiving Your love. I choose to believe Your Word and confess Your truth over my life. In doing so, Father, I Thank You, for You transform me, change me and make me more and more into the person You created and redeemed me to be. AMEN!

THE LABELS WE CARRY STRONGHOLDS MOVING FROM ENTANGLED TO UNTANGLED

KEY SCRIPTURES

2 Samuel 4:4 NKJV – "Jonathan, Saul's son, had a son who was lame in his feet. He was five years old when the news about Saul and Jonathan came from Jezreel; and his nurse took him up and fled. And it happened, as she made haste to flee, that he fell and became lame. His name was Mephibosheth."

2 Samuel 9:3-13 NKJV - "Then the king said, 'Is there not still someone of the house of Saul, to whom I may show the kindness of God?' So the king said to him, 'Where is he?' And Ziba said to the king, 'Indeed he is in the house of Machir the son of Ammiel, in Lo Debar.' Then King David sent and brought him out of the house of Machir the son of Ammiel, from Lo Debar. Now when Mephibosheth the son of Jonathan, the son of Saul, had come to David, he fell on his face and prostrated himself. Then David said, 'Mephibosheth?' And he answered, 'Here is your servant!' So David said to him, 'Do not fear, for I will surely show you kindness for Jonathan your father's sake, and will restore to you all the land of Saul your grandfather; and you shall eat bread at my table continually.' Then he bowed himself, and said, 'What is your servant, that you should look upon such a dead dog as I' And the king called to Ziba, Saul's servant, and said to him, 'I have given to your master's son all that belonged to Saul and to all his house. You therefore, and your sons and your servants, shall work the land for him, and you shall bring in the harvest, that your master's son may have food to eat. But Mephibosheth your master's son shall eat bread at my table always.' Now Ziba had fifteen sons and twenty servants. Then Ziba said to the king, 'According to all that my lord the king has commanded his servant, so will your servant do.' 'As for Mephibosheth,' said the king, 'he shall eat at my table[a] like one of the king's sons.' Mephibosheth had a young son whose name was Micha. And all who dwelt in the house of Ziba were servants of Mephibosheth. So Mephibosheth dwelt in Jerusalem, for he ate continually at the king's table. And he was lame in both his feet."

APPLICATION

What is a stronghold?

 In Greek, the word "stronghold" is a military word, which is synonymous to fortress. It refers to an area where the enemy is entrenched. It is a wrong pattern of thinking, which can give the enemy a right in our life. This fortress of thought gives the enemy a place to secure a "strong hold" in your life.

How does this happen?

• In our personal life, they are established through an event, which we have personally been through or witnessed. A stronghold is formed when a soul wound and a core lie are brought together.

Why are strongholds a problem?

When we look to anything or anyone, other than God as our source, idolatry
enters into the circumstance or situation. The thing or the person that we are
seeking becomes our source of truth and not God. You are allowing the enemy to
define the truth, rather than allowing God's truth to be present. When we take
comfort in the person or the thing we are seeking as truth, we begin to build a
defense to protect ourselves.

When a stronghold exists, you have likely made the enemy your source of truth. When a stronghold exists, you have likely made yourself your source of protection.

The only true solution for pulling down these strongholds would be, true repentance.

- Repentance is not a change in behavior; it's a change in how you perceive reality.
- Repentance is changing your source: New Source of Truth, New Source of Security/Comfort.
- Repentance is a response to God's Word.

The Event: (Typically Negative)

The event can be a hurt, trauma or generational iniquity.

The Lie: (The meaning you assigned to the event.)

Often times, this is where the voice of the enemy comes and tells you what this hurt or trauma means. These meanings are lies that you inherit and embrace. They can be lies that you believe about God, yourself and others.

The Defense: (The way you avoid pain, anxiety, hurt or disappointment.) Defenses are the ways in which we choose to protect or comfort ourselves.

The Reaction: (How others react to the defense.) It may sound like, "How can I change you, so you will stop doing that to me?"

KEY SCRIPTURES

2 Corinthians 10:4-6 NKJV – "For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled."

Hebrews 12:1-3 AMP – ""Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider Him who has endured such hostility by sinners against Himself, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart."

John 20:25-29 ESV – So the other disciples told him, 'We have seen the Lord.' But he said to them, 'Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into his side, I will never believe.' Eight days later, his disciples were inside again, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, 'Peace be with you.' Then he said to Thomas, 'Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side. Do not disbelieve, but believe.' Thomas answered him, 'My Lord and my God!' Jesus said to him, 'Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.'''

As the Lord shows you the event, ask: Lord, what lie did I believe when this event happened? As He shows you the lie, agree with Him, repent and renounce the lie you believed. Ask: Lord, what is Your truth about this event? As He shows you the truth, agree and receive His truth.

'Now his older son was in the field, and as he came and drew near to the house, he heard music and dancing. And he called one of the servants and asked what these things meant. And he said to him, "Your brother has come, and your father has killed the fattened calf, because he has received him back safe and sound." But he was angry and refused to go in. His father came out and entreated him, but he answered his father, "Look, these many years I have served you, and I never disobeyed your command, yet you never gave me a young goat, that I might celebrate with my friends. But when this son of yours came, who has devoured your property with prostitutes, you killed the fattened calf for him!" And he said to him, "Son, you are always with me, and all that is mine is yours. It was fitting to celebrate and be glad, for this your brother was dead, and is alive; he was lost, and is found.""

APPLICATION

Six Wounding Mothering Styles (Taken from Our Mothers, Ourselves, by Dr. H. Cloud and Dr. J. Townsend)

- The Phantom Mother: A mothering style that is physically or emotionally detached and/or absent.
- The China Doll Mother: A mothering style that is unable to deal with unpleasant or stressful situations.
- The Controlling Mother: A mothering style that enforces limits to keep the child from being different from herself.
- The Trophy Mother: A mothering style that can only give acceptance and approval because they believe the child has to have it all together, in order to be close and involved in the child's life.
- The Still the Boss Mother: A mothering style which produces a permanent child. They are always focused on the child becoming an autonomous, functioning adult.
- The American Express Mother: A mothering style where there is always a balance owed and they cannot separate from their child.

Five Wounding Fathering Styles (Taken from The Teleious Man, by Larry Titus)

- The Emotionally Detached Father: A fathering style where he is present, however, he is emotionally void.
- The Abusive Father: A fathering style where verbal, emotional or physical abuse are consistently present.
- The Performance-Based Father: A fathering style where the relationship is based solely on performance.
- The Hyper-Competitive Father: A fathering style where he views the child as competition.
- The Absent Father: A fathering style where the father is absent due to choice or circumstances.

Seven Attributes of the Nature of God (Taken from Freedom From Your Past, by Jimmy Evans and Ann Billington)

God is Holy. (Holy means "separated from sin.")
